The Autonomous e-Mobility Forum Unveils its Program and International Speakers Lineup 2024

Qatar Ministry of Transport Lifts the Curtain for Pre-Event Press Conference

Doha, Qatar - 21 April 2024 - The Autonomous e-Mobility (AEMOB) Forum 2024, held under the patronage of His Excellency, Jassim Saif Ahmed Al Sulaiti, Minister of Transport, and hosted by its strategic partner, the Ministry of Transport (MOT) of the State of Qatar, revealed its final program and speakers lineup in a press conference held at the Ministry on Monday, 22 April.

Speaking at the occasion, Eng. Hamad Essa Abdullah, MOT Acting Assistant Undersecretary, Land Transport Affairs said, "The world is facing a critical turning point in meeting the urgent need for sustainable transportation solutions, and among the promising alternatives in this field are electric and self-driving vehicles, which are a giant leap and a transformative trend in the





field of transportation. The future of electric vehicles is aligned with global sustainability efforts thanks to their ability to reduce emissions, increase energy efficiency, and provide innovative mobility solutions that address climate change."

Abdullah added that Qatar is advancing in implementing a strategy for the gradual adoption and expansion of electric vehicles. Over 70% of the public bus fleet has already transitioned to electric buses, with plans to reach 100% by 2030.

He emphasized that the Ministry's hosting of AEMOB aims to provide an ideal platform for industry leaders, policymakers, officials, experts, speakers, and representatives from various sectors to enhance knowledge, exchange experiences, explore cooperation opportunities, and formulate recommendations for the practical implementation of electric and self-driving vehicles.

Mr. Abdulla Ali Al-Mawlawi, Communication & Public Relations Director at Qatar Rail stated, "We are pleased to participate as a gold sponsor of the first international Autonomous e-Mobility Forum, hosted by the Ministry of Transport and organized by Just us & Otto Company under the patronage of His Excellency Mr. Jassim bin Saif Al Sulaiti, Minister of Transport."
